

### NOTIFICATION

The New Jersey Department of Transportation would like to take this opportunity to notify the community and businesses in the area of Route 10 Eastbound and Westbound and Eyland Avenue in Roxbury Township, Morris County of the upcoming Reconstruction of the Route 10 Railroad Crossing.

This work will require the full closure of Route 10 between Eyland Avenue and Main Street intersections from **Friday, October 21, 2016 at 6:00 PM Eastbound and 8:00 PM Westbound until Monday, October 24, 2016 at 6:00 AM**. There will be posted detour routes for the Route 10 Eastbound traffic which will require a right onto Eyland Avenue; a left onto Righter Road; left onto Park Avenue; right onto Sussex Turnpike; and left onto Canfield Avenue and then back to Route 10 Eastbound.

The Route 10 Westbound detour will also be posted and will require a right turn onto Main Street and then a left turn onto Eyland Avenue and a right turn back onto Route 10 Westbound.

A temporary access road will be constructed across the Route 10 median prior to the railroad tracks (if traveling westbound on Route 10) to allow Route 10 Westbound traffic to access businesses on Route 10 Eastbound by making a "u-turn" and then heading in an easterly direction. The existing Railroad Crossing will be removed and a new concrete railroad crossing will be installed with a new asphalt approach. The detour will be coordinated with the local police.
